Minimum starting bid is \$20.00. Lunch will be available.**

The rules of the silent auction

Sellers : Birds must be entered before the Auction day as we need to know how much staging etc. (you just need to let us know how many cages you are entering)

Commission is 5% to the club on each bird sold.

Sellers are to put an opening bid on their own birds.

Sellers do not have to be members of ABS.

Sellers please provide information about the birds on the attached bidding sheet – as this helps the bird to sell.

Buyers:

Buyers must register on the day and will receive a bidders number .

Buyers registration is free. All money has to be paid in cash.

Running of the silent auction

Each bird will be given a lot number and a bidding sheet which will be attached to the show cage.

The Sellers bid will be the opening bid on the sheet & then you put down what price you want to bid in \$5 increments. Approximately 5 mins to closing time it will be announced that bidding is about to stop, then final call & all are to step back from the cages - then each lot number, bidding price & bidder number will be called out and that bird is sold to that bidder. Please bring along your own cages to take birds home!
